
The Dust Suppression Action Plan prioritizes and identifies approximately 8,200 acres of dust suppression projects on emissive lakebed at locations around the Salton Sea, including up to 3,800 acres identified for completion in 2020. The projects, to be constructed in strategic locations along the perimeter of the Sea over two phases, will target the most emissive sites to help control dust from exposed lakebed areas and limit Searelated impacts on air quality for communities such as Salton City, Bombay Beach and North Shore.

Goals

- Phase A: Approximately 3,800 acres of surface roughening projects for completion in 2020
- Phase B: Vegetation establishment where possible and approximately 4,400 acres of additional projects
- Community Benefit: Reduced dust to minimize air quality impacts
